

Tropical Soup Benefits Guide- Open Enrollment

When you can change your coverage:

1. 90 days after your hire date when you become eligible for coverage.
2. Open Enrollment, the month of June.
3. When you notify HR* **within 30 days** of a “qualifying event” such as:
 - a. Birth or adoption of a child
 - b. Getting married, divorced, or legally separated
 - c. Changing from part-time to full-time employment
 - d. Change in child custody or court order to provide coverage for a child
 - e. Your spouse/domestic partner loses or gains insurance eligibility or there is a significant change to their coverage
 - f. You or a family member becomes eligible for Medicaid, Medicare, etc
 - g. Death of spouse or dependent

What to Know:

- Your carrier is Florida Blue (BCBS)

- In the state of Florida, pharmacies are required to dispense generic before brand medications.
- Quest Diagnostics is your laboratory provider.
- You pay for benefits pre-tax.
- Selecting a primary care provider (PCP) is not required.

Routine Wellness Services:

If you are on the medical plan, the following preventative services are 100% covered and there is no cost (no copay, no coinsurance, no deductible).

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- If polyps are found it will be considered a diagnosis

Register Online:

Pricing:

For just the individual employee (yourself), deductions from checks would be:

\$210 or \$150 for medical, depending on your income.

\$3.61 for vision

Currently, this amount is about 30% of the cost. Your employer pays the other 70%.

This pricing assumes that there are two paychecks per month—when there is a third paycheck, you will not be charged.

If you make most of your money through tips or for some other reason have a check that won't cover this amount (including if you are out on leave), we will invoice you the difference. This invoiced amount must be paid within 5 days of payday.

Tiers of coverage for the individual + spouse, individual + child(ren), individual + family are also available for a higher cost.
